Symptom:

The game is not initially percentaging well. The high

score is too easy to beat.

Problem:

The European player is a better pinball player than

the American player.

Solution:

We recommend that in Europe the high score be set to 2,900,000 and the backup high scores be increased by 2,000,000 points. This is done as follows:

- 1. Access adjustment number AD02
- 2. Use the credit button to increase the score from 1,900,000 to 2,900,000.
- 3. Access adjustment number EAD 32, 33, 34, and 35.
- 4. Use the credit button to increase them by 2,000,000 points each.

Note: The game is equipped with manual replay percentaging. This will cause the game to seek the best replay level for the particular location it is in regardless of what the high scores are intitally set to. This score recommendation is made so the game will percentage better when first put on location.
